The homeowners chose to have No-Burn® Wood Gard Mih applied to the entire wood framing, protecting the structure against fire while also resisting the growth of toxic black mold. Miller Construction is pleased with the homes that have been treated with No-Burn® fire and mold protection coatings, and they have additional homes lined up for the No-Burn® Dealer to treat.

In the Fox Run Development, the homeowners now have the choice to apply a fire retardant coating as an alternative to sprinkler systems for fire protection for their new home.
