Project Background

Due to some design complications, the general contractor responsible for building this “shoppette” facility was seeking an alternative to providing automatic fire sprinklers as the fire protection approach for the combustible concealed space (attic) of the building. The chosen solution was the application of No-Burn[®] Plus to the exposed wood (OSB) surfaces in this space pursuant to an exception in the NFPA 13 Standard that provides this allowance. The project was allowed to proceed on time and with considerably less expense as a result of the No-Burn[®] solution.

Value to Purchaser

Various conditions associated with this project made the installation of an automatic sprinkler system in the attic impractical and costly. By choosing the No-Burn[®] option, the construction process was accelerated, the total project cost was reduced and the building owner will now be able to avoid ongoing expenses for maintenance and inspections.
