Project Background

Twelve Concession Stands have been remodeled at the Panther's Stadium in Charlotte, NC. Wood for these structures were torn down from an old barn and rebuilt to have a "stressed look." The Fire Marshal told the owner of the stadium that the wood needed to be fire retardant. The owner recalled the benefits of No-Burn® from previous projects. After testing of No-Burn® Original on samples of the wood from the concession stands, the Fire Marshal accepted this project. The No-Burn® Dealer applied No-Burn® Original to all of the raw wood of the structures, a total of 12,000 square feet, giving the wood a "Class A" rating.

Value to Purchaser

With the application of No-Burn® Original on the wood substrates of the Panther Stadium's concession stands, the owner estimated savings of about \$20,000. Because of the requirements of the Fire Marshal wanting the wood to be fire retardant, the owner had two options. The first option was to use a type of fire retardant treated wood. With this route, the owner would have had to purchase all new wood, and the concession stands would have lost the "stressed look" of the wood. The second option was to use No-Burn® fire retardant coatings. No-Burn® Original allowed the owner to reuse the wood from an old barn, and the concession stands were able to keep its "stressed look" that the owner wanted. Because the owner was able to cut the cost of materials, he was able to cut the cost of the project tremendously.
