## Project Background

An all girls' school, owned by the State of Wyoming, required sprinklers to be installed to the entire structure, plus eight dormer units located on the second floor. Big Sky Fire Protection, a local sprinkler installation company, submitted a bid to install sprinklers to the entire structure. To lower the bid, Big Sky Fire Protection contacted the local Certified No-Burn® Dealer, Dependable Paint and Drywall, to treat the dormer units. A request was submitted to the State of Wyoming to allow No-Burn® Wood Gard Mih as an alternative to sprinklers in the dormer units of the structure, and it was accepted by the inspector. The No-Burn® Dealer treated the eight dormer units with No-Burn® Wood Gard Mih, and Big Sky Fire Protection installed sprinklers in other required areas.

## Value to Purchaser

Big Sky Fire Protection was able to present a lower price to outbid other companies. Both sprinklers and the treatment of the No-Burn® Wood Gard Mih will provide fire protection to the entire structure, with additional protection against the spread of toxic, black mold in the dormer units, improving the indoor air quality.

The contractor has been concerned with mold growth from previously untreated structures.
